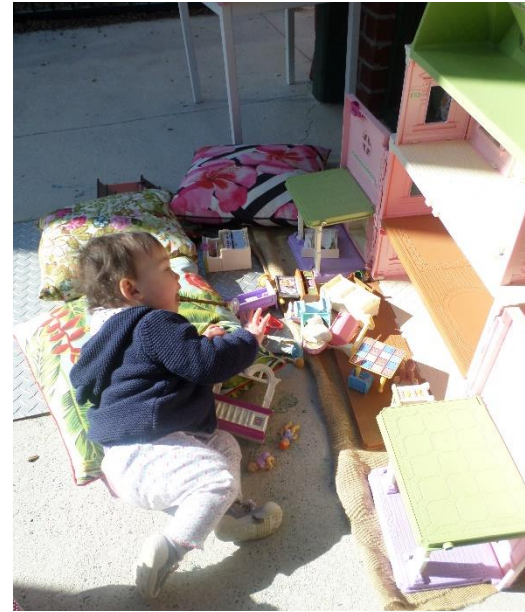


# August 2017 Reflection



Due to the children's growing interest about one another and placing themselves in the context of community and extending on learning who they are within our community, we have set up a doll house with little miniature furniture and little people, where the children are able to sort and manipulate the group by hand, use their imagination and pretend scenarios, maybe scenes that they have seen and heard from home, transferring that experience to another placing themselves as the main actor and controller.

We have also extended our home corner into a baby corner with baby dolls, cots and food with utensils where they can change baby's clothes, put them to sleep and feed them. The children love taking them around the room onto their next experience, some have enjoyed putting them to sleep in their cots, patting and singing little lullabies, while others been busy cooking up a storm or cleaning after the babies
