

Reflections Koala Room February 2017

This month has seen the children settling in nicely and enjoying the vast array of activities offered in Koala Room. The children have particularly enjoyed role play this month with our Dramatic Play space being turned into a hospital. The children have been co-operating and communicating to enjoy play episodes. We have been singing Miss Polly had a Dolly, talking about hospital and role playing with the children.

Bubble Blowing has been a favourite for the children. Skills such as holding the bubble blower and lining up to the mouth area whilst blowing with the correct amount of force to form a bubble was challenging so we have included Paint blowing using straws to assist with this skill development. The children have enjoyed being creative and watching paint move across their page.
