During the second part of June we have been monitoring our vegetable crops indoors and outdoors and watering rosters are in place. The children have been enjoying learning about letters and numbers and how they are grouped to form words. We are encouraging the children to search out the first letter of their names whenever the opportunity arises at play. A name and picture chart is being introduced. Our koalas continue to form small group friendships and navigate their way through listening, taking turns and expressing themselves.

These skills are useful in being able to maintain short shared play episodes. Our popular hair salon is assisting with this process. Different block play opportunities are popular and engineering is taking place everywhere. We visited the Kinder room and exchanged some songs and fingerplays with them.

The children from Kinder then came to visit our Room and the Koalas again showed off their singing skills and we shared a story about a dog who kept eating different shaped and coloured items. During mat time the children are taking turns briefly speaking to the group. This is delightful.
