

Reflections Koala Room June 2017



During the first part of June, we have seen the Children spending a little more time inside the Koala Room due to the cooler weather. Our enthusiastic hair stylists have been busy co-operating together in role play and some amazing things with hairstyling are happening. Children are sharing clips, talking about what they are doing and asking each other to do their hair. Our insect discovery is extended and the science and sustainability project is continuing with outdoor and terrarium plantings taking place. The existing outdoor carrots will be picked and eaten soon. We just planted Radish and carrot into a terrarium. Growing root vegetables under glass can show children what happens beneath the soil. Outdoors we have just planted cabbage, parsley and beans. We are introducing a Photo and name chart for the children to recognise their names. We are talking about letters and numbers and how symbols represent them. We had an incursion visit to the Kinder Room where the Koalas presented a couple of songs and finger-plays and the Kindergarten children reciprocated with some of their own. Outdoors we converted the digging patch into an African animal area for the children to explore. Our natural tinkering table was producing some amazing ideas and the social skill levels continue to grow enabling the children to share ideas and play thoughts with one another. Friendships are forming in pairs and small groups.
