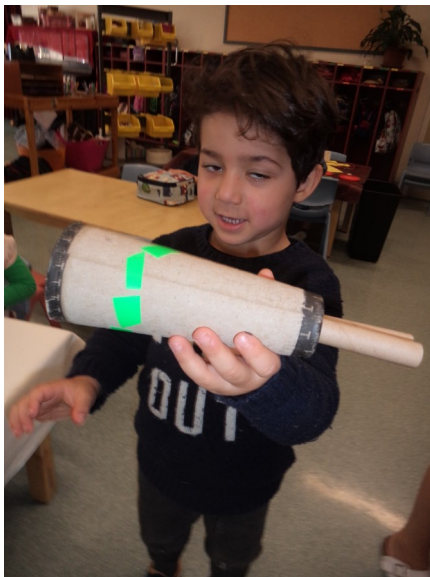


Ahoy there!!! What can I see?
