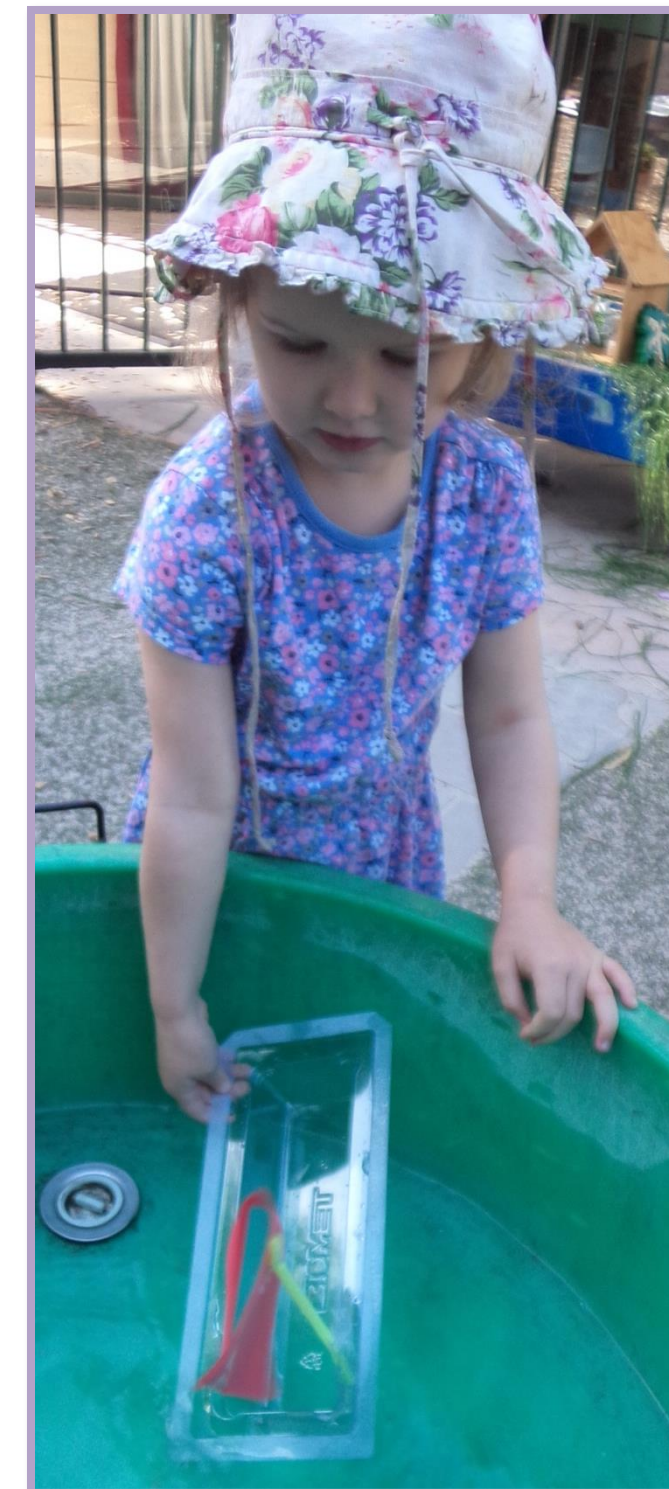


March Reflection 2017
