

# Purple Group Reflection. Term 2. Week 1

Outcome 4: Children are confident and involved learners.

NQS 1: Educational program and practice



**LEFT:** The children learn this week about Jupiter and it's great red spot on the planet – one that is the most violent storm known in the universe and one that Sheshily has been caught up in!

Demonstrating the nature of Jupiter (most colourful - red/orange/yellow) - swirly winds through baking a Jupiter cake





Demonstrating, via a science activity, that Jupiter is the stormiest planet in the Solar System. A bi-carb soda ball was made using water to paste it together and colour added. The children took turns adding drops of white vinegar to it – making the ball fizz!



Relay races and introducing scoring system via keeping a tally – in line with our data project!

Sheshily is saved from the great red spot and sends it back to Earth with traces of her red hair still remaining in it for the children to find!
