This month has been very short as a result of school holidays and the Anzac Day public holiday so we have had a strong focus on resettling the group, focussing on relationships, and reestablishing the existing routines. The children have enjoyed the new elements to the program and the changes made to reflect their interests and goals. Last week the children were off on Thursday due to the public holiday. So, on Friday we took the opportunity to discuss with the children why we had the day off from work and kinder. It was a positive intentional learning experience to discuss how our country is protected and why we give thanks to the men and women who serve to keep it safe.
