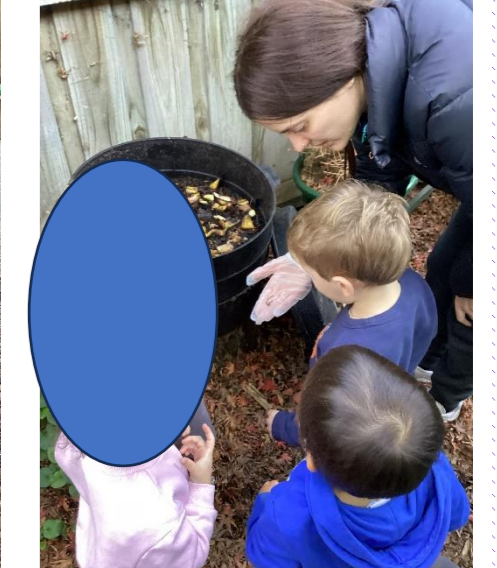
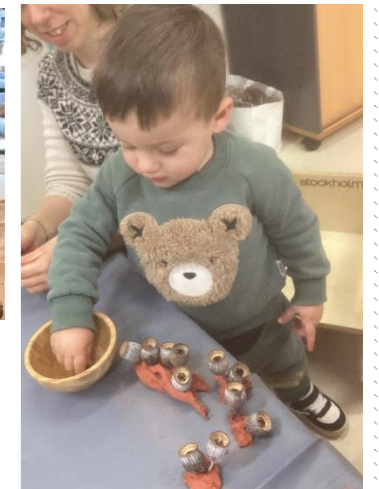


This month our children have enjoyed a range of experiences including Butterfly kids, working with clay, music and movement sessions and a lovely visit from our student Frances.

In our music and movement sessions, we use a range of resources including stretchy Lycra, shakers and coloured scarves. Through these sessions the children are building on their core muscles as well as following instructions. But most importantly having fun getting their wiggles out.
